To develop and enhance participants' leadership skills and abilities

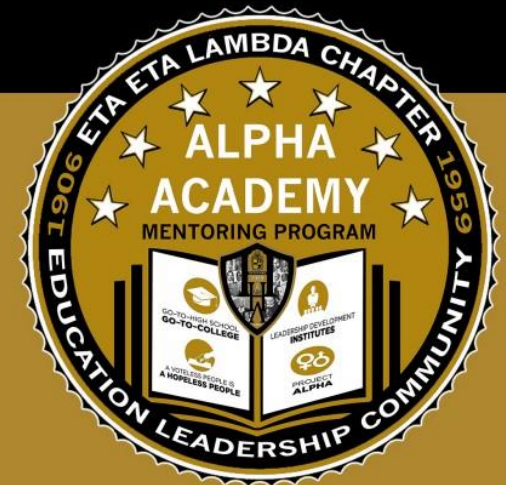
To promote and stimulate an appreciation for continued education beyond high school, and community involvement

COLLEGE TOURS

We expose our mentees to various post-high school education options, which include visiting college campuses, exploring military academies, and learning about trade schools.



STEM FOCUSED

Mentees participate in STEM building activities and projects such as the Pinewood Derby car project where mentees build cars from a block of wood to race other mentor programs as well as themselves.



FINANCIAL LITERACY

Our high school mentees learn about building credit, establishing and maintaining bank accounts, and receive an introduction to investing.
